It offers sweeping views along both north and south beaches and provides an ideal vantage point for avid anglers to check out beach formations before venturing out to try their luck.

The walking track out to the front of the headland is well formed and takes less than half an hour.

It's an ideal spot for light picnics or an afternoon lazing in the sun, sipping a cool wine or simply relaxing with a good book. Why not take along a fishing rod and try your luck?
